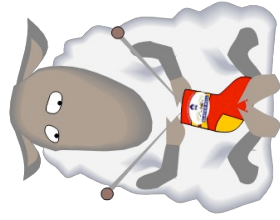

Short Row Sleeve Cap – Gudrun Johnston Saturday 10AM-1PM

This class will cover the basics of working a short row sleeve cap to create a seamless set in sleeve. We will use a mini armscythe to practice picking up stitches and working the short rows. We will also discuss the differences between this particular construction versus seamed sweaters and how to convert a seamed sleeve into a seamless one. Some experience in sweater knitting is encouraged.....\$45

Aestlight Shawl - Gudrun Johnston Saturday 2PM-5PM

Learn one of the traditional shawl making methods from the Shetland Isles. The three- part construction of this shawl begins with a garter stitch triangle. Stitches are then easily picked up along the edges and the border is worked outwards from the triangle. The shawl is finished with an edging that is knitted sideways and attached to the live stitches of the border as it is being worked. We'll practice each of the steps separately so that students leave with the necessary skills to make their own "Aestlight" in their favorite fingering weight yarn. A copy of the pattern will be provided. Some experience with lace and chart reading is encouraged.....\$45

Kurpas and Puntas - Mary Jane Mucklestone Saturday 10AM-4PM

Explore Andean Knitting. Learning different methods for making the Andean popcorn stitch, and a traditional scalloped edging, students will begin to construct a sweet baby hat .....\$100

Knitting Wired-Adrienne Sloane Saturday 10AM-4PM

An introduction to knitting and crocheting with wire, this workshop will cover resources, materials and design ideas for successful wire knit and crochet, getting students started on basic techniques using beautifully colored art wire. Beginning with bracelets, the class will cover adding beads and found objects to the work as participants create delicate and unusual artistic jewelry. Previous wire or jewelry making not required but basic knit or crochet skills necessary..... \$100
